Create a comfortable environment and a WOW first impression for guests and members by providing a safe environment.

Guidelines

Arrive on time (9:15 AM) and check-in with the Safety Team lead.

The primary team lead positions himself in the foyer area.

The secondary primary area is E wing safety and roaming the campus. The backup serves as a fill-in if one of the two scheduled security members cannot serve, or as additional assistance upon request.

The auditorium side doors are automatically locked at 10:45 AM to prevent entry and funnel late arrivals through the foyer doors.

Use a church-provided radio for communication.

Genuinely acknowledge Guests as they walk to the building and help guests as needed. Greeting guest also helps assess individuals we are unfamiliar with.

Stay in your assigned area until 11:45 AM. Our team can't be successful without every member!

Refrain from eating, drinking, or using your phone while serving.

Investigate any accidents, suspicious activity, or suspicious person(s). The Safety Team's primary goal is to deter and deescalate. If the security team is informed of suspicious activity, they will be the primary person to contact suspicious activity.

If you will miss your opportunity to serve, please inform your team leader.

Coordinate with the team leader, Jason Anderson and Matt Rector. Currently, we are serving one weekend a month, but with more members, we hope it is once every six weeks.
